What happens at Teen Court?

Teen Court panelists hear the facts of a case for a defendant who has already pled guilty on a minor offense. They then assign sanctions based on principles of restorative justice, which means the consequences are educational and help victims as well as the defendant. Defendants who complete their sanctions within 6 months do not have to pay fines, their offenses are removed from their records, and they can be restored to a positive position in their community.
